Consequences of Not believing R
If there ~~is~~ ~~was~~ ~~no~~ ~~resurrection~~
Then ① - Christ did not rise
② N.T. message meaningless
③ Apostles lied
④ whole thing is a hoax
⑤ you are still in your sins

But since
X Christ has paid for all our sins -
the evidence that He has is His
resurrection - He'd still be dead
if there were any un-paid-for
sins.

The reason people never get out of
hell is that they are ~~still~~ always
going to be paying for their own
sins.

Christ was SIN-LESS - he is God
so he could pay for our sins

Paul shows logically how
necessary the literal bodily
resurrection of Christ is - you
cannot have Christianity without Christ's
resurrection, like the liberals say

It is a hoax - without the resurrection
Christ is either God - + rose ~~or~~ or else
reject Him - don't try to water

"First-fruits" - Sunday right after Christ's death He 1st One to rise from the dead - He is the First Fruit of eternal body
IP 1:3-5 Rom. 8:23 - We have the 1st Fruits of Spirit, but not body

(V. 22) - "In A dam all die" - unbelievers
"In Christ" all made alive" - believers
you are only "in Christ" WHEN you believe

2a) II With what [Body] do they come?

The resurrection body of the righteous:

- ① Will be like the resurrection body of the Lord Jesus Christ (I Cor. 15:49)
- ② The body will be "glorious" (Phil 3:21)
- ③ We shall see Him as He is (I Jo. 3:2)
- ④ Fully developed, complete (no babies)
- ⑤ A Sensine body of flesh + bones (Lu. 24:36-43, I Jo. 1:1-2)

⑥ Exactly the same as the one you have - "Christ shall change our vile body", but not exchange it (Phil. 3:21)

⑦ Not the original substance (I Cor 15:37) the identity remains the same, but the substance changes

⑧ The structure remains the same but it will be a body that adapts to the new sphere in which it will function - it will be changed for its new function + purpose (I Cor. 15:39)

⑨ (I Cor. 15: 45) "Natural" - body (Adam's) was adapted to the use + expression of the [Soul] through 5 senses

"Spiritual" is a body given by last Adam Christ for the use + expression of the [Spirit] of God through our human spirit which relates us to God

Christ's body was flesh + blood before the cross than He gave up His blood

After Resurrection he had a body of flesh + bones (Lu. 24:39)

Millennial Kingdom

The Teaching about the Kingdom of God is really the grand central theme of the Bible with the God of the Universe revealed in the Lord Jesus Christ.

When following Jesus as Lord & Saviour the resurrected Christ inevitably leads **us** to His Kingdom where He rules.

The dominion that was given to Adam by God - and then forfeited by the first Adam has now been judicially given by God to the Last Adam - Christ.

This kingdom & dominion will eventually be realized on earth in the final stage of human history called The Medietorial Kingdom or Millennial Kingdom.

In this kingdom the throne of God and of the Lamb (Rev. 22:3) will be established as sovereign and eternal.

Much of O.T. prophecy concerns this kingdom.

1) The ruler will be both human & divine
"a man" (Isa. 32:1-2, 11:1)
"The Lord your God" (Isa. 40:9-10)

2) The form of the kingdom will be monarchy
"I have set my King upon my Holy hill of Zion" (Ps. 2:6)
with a well ordered system of govt - legis. judicial & executive (Zech. 14:9, Isa. 33:17-24)

3) Nature of the Kingdom 4) Spiritual with a direct knowledge of God (Jer. 31:34)
