Seraphim's song: Holy, Holy, Holy - emphasis in Hebrew & nowhere else is it repeated 3 times - Holiness encompasses all God's attributes

The Trauma of Holiness - "Woe is me" - Isaiah's response
Oracle - prophecy - woe - divine favor - Blessed

~~Woe~~
God's announcement of Divine Favor

Woe - God's announcement of doom

I am undone - coming apart at the seams

integrity - a together person

undean lips mouths - delivers the heart's evilness

(N.S.) God cauterizes the man's wound

- his lips - and forgives him.

→ Real repentance is always painful

Here am I, send me - motivation & impetus

for christian work is for people to find

forgiveness

- The definition of the Holiness of God

The term holy in 2 ways -

Secondary meaning - purity of God, all of His behavior is righteous

Primary meaning: separation, consecration

set-apartness. God is OTHER - how can we

define what is 'other' or different?

Transcendence - above & beyond us

analysis - plot, plot - good & interesting
but expect to find evidence & evidence -
that the circumstances are similar - similar
activities

proposed Israel - was it "accidental" or intentional?
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We are creatures - finite - temporal - dependent
God is infinite, eternal, independent

Why is there something instead of nothing
Because of "being" - eternal - HOLY

He has the power of being - He can bring
something out of nothing

that which provokes a sense of mystery

↳ incites within us a sense of fear

Man fears coming into the presence
of a transcendent holy God

Yet at the same time we are fascinated by it
We flee from intimate contact & holiness

the weather

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Holiness of God

⇒ of Christ

he was killed because of the responses we have towards God's Holiness

when the true Holy One came the facade of the pharisees broke

when Jesus stilled the storm the disciples asked "What kind of man is this that even the storms obey him"

Xenophobia - afraid of the stranger - they couldn't find a category to put Jesus in
Peter → "Depart from me for I am a sinful man" I feel dirty - your holiness is too much to bear
The world wants space & room from Jesus

Justice -

what God is & what He does

Internal justice - Holiness

External justice - out-working of his Holiness

The Judge of all the world must do right always does right

(Lev 10:1-5) Presumptuous to God

Principle: if there is a passage in Scripture you don't like you need to study it

you've never come to grips with the Holiness of God. If you are offended by his justice

you are out of touch with his Holiness

O.T. is a picture of God's Grace - He was so patient with Israel

The word "eternal" is used in the beginning of the Gospel of John. It is a Greek word, αἰώνιος, which means "eternal" or "everlasting".
