"Realm of the dead" - Mesopotamia close to the surface

"Sheol" - meaning not known - pit, or opp. of heaven,
death Ps. 89:49, Job. 24: - grave, Num. 16 Is. 14

O.T. Spirits under Job. 26:5, Ps. whither shall I go
the see - or ground

Ps. 73:8-16 - Judgment & after-life
(mesapt. - gross crime punished, cont. present life)

O.T. - sleep - body, not the spirit

Isa. 66:24 - fear & torment

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Moses

Def. 'draw out'

Exile - Midian SE Sinai (mt. Horeb)

40 yrs - preparation by God for wanderings

Burning bush Ex. 3:11 - "who am I?" v. 12 - God's Provision

13 - no message

v. 15 - "Ward & N."

14 - no authority

4:2-4 - "Power & Witness"

4:10 - no eloquence

4:11-12 - "provides eloquence"

4:13 - his own fear

4:14-17 - rebuke, holds hand

v. 24 - God putting Moses to death

Zipporah circumcised her son

God made her "their son" - holds Moses

Revelation of Purpose: Ex. 3:19 - God knows Pharaoh's heart

This proves that God knew beforehand Pharaoh's heart

God elects how history goes Foreknowledge

~~1~~ Pet. 1:1-2 - foreknowledge God

Rom. 8:29 - "

Choice on basis of election or foreknowledge

Rom. 9 - Does God, in fact, violate free will?

Esau = Edom, Jacob = Israel

Ishmael = Arab, Isaac = Israel

national election of your Jewishness or your gentile-ness

Predestination is for your function not your eternal destiny

Election of Grace = as a Jew -

Election of Salvation = Believer

"hardened" = strengthen means to give courage

In. ch. 9:11 (after 7 plagues) 1st time God 'hardened' Pharaoh

Ex. 14 - Red Sea - Final hardening

made Ph. so tough that he went into walls of water - Boldness

(17:12) "supported" his hands - same word as hardening
Pot - Israel Potter - God - destiny of a nation

14:14 - "you keep silent" - behavior of Belief

Passover Ex. 12

Type of Redemption - house is sanctified
Jo. 1:29, I Cor. 5:7 -

Jesus was slain on Passover -

v. 9 - Roasted in fire - judgment
eating - personally partaking

v. 11 eat standing - renounce world, go out

v. 46 - no bone broken -

Bread unleavened - no sin

Ex. 14, 17 - Grumbling

In Ex. 19 - Cov't given & agreed to by them
then God punished

32: Golden Calf - fertility god - had sexual
orgy

Gold - God decreed that they take out gold
but they made an idol out of gold -
God made them drink it - feces

I Cor. 10 - Baptized into Moses - Picture of Christ

Christ intercedes for us

New things do happen to God, but His Character doesn't change

Numbers 11-

Grumbled about lack of meat - wanted Egyptian meat - God gave them meat

Christians They wanted what they had in the world

God gave it - they got sick - a plague

Problem: Authority + Obedience - Rebellion against

1. Authority is ordained to provide Protection + promote Order (Eph. 5 - family)

In church → elders, bishops, shepherd

- serves, keeps flock together I Cor. 14

- order -

- pasture water = feeds

Obedience = FAITH = Heb. 11, Jo. 6:27-29, includes all good things

⇒ In universe God's Authority - Satan's Rebellion

Obedience is greater than sacrifice - service is not as great as obedience

Moses - delegated authority - as if it were God speaking "He who receives you, receives me" - Jesus
