Babylon fell - 539  
Zechariah - 520 in Babylon  
Ezra - 453 back to Israel, teach law  
Nehemiah - 444 builds wall in 52 days  
Esther - Zeph - during exile

### Apocalyptic book

ch. 5:1-4 flying scroll -  
5:5-11 - mystery Babylon (Rev. 17) lead cover H.S.  
Plain of Shinar - Babylon Commerce - ephah  
Revelation - religious + political system.

Not by might nor by power but by my Spirit  
saith the Lord Zech. 4:6

Ch. 9 - Alexander the Great - (v. 8)

(v. 9-10) - Messianic prophecy - King, salvation,  
coming into Jer. humble - on foal of donkey  
- next verse millennial kingdom

God knows all, not from causality, but from foreknowledge.  
Mill. Kingdom offered, not as a blessing, but  
condemnation - they had the chance and  
refused His offer

God broke staff of favor

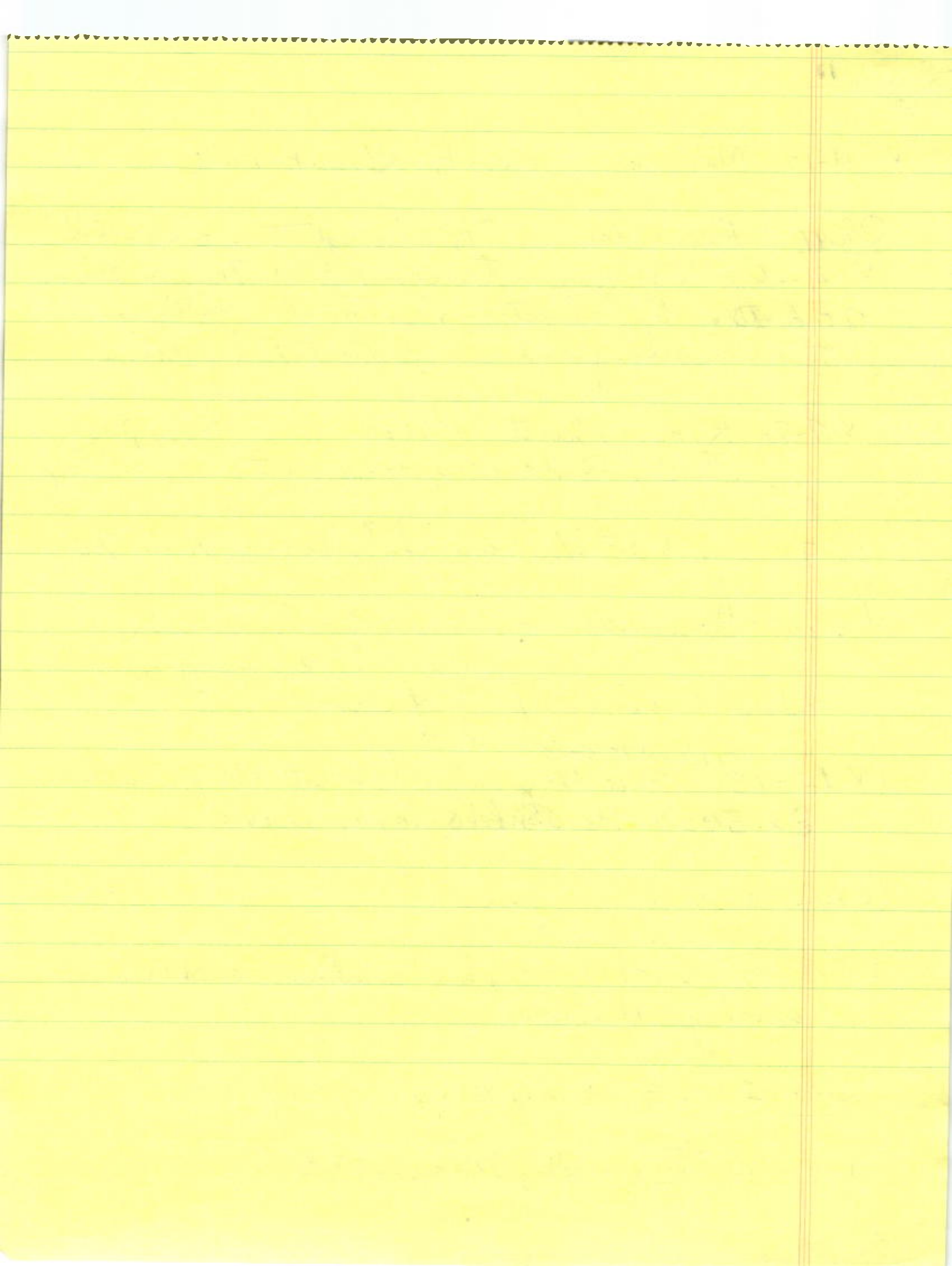
(v. 12-13) - <sup>Mat. 27:3-10</sup> Price they value Christ 30 ps. silver

How Gods Will Gets Done:

1. God initiates by giving burden to someone about God's will 1:3-4
2. Pray some more - See if it's Godly burden it will grow 1:4-7
3. Remember God's Promises - grounding in Scriptural 1:8-11 Only Scripture is firm enough
4. Nehemiah does whatever He can 1:16-2:8 - God gives burden to the one who is able to do it - uniquely gifted
5. Went about planning. 2:9-20

## 7. Opposition from Satan

How to handle

① Mocking by disdainful people  
4:1-6 Response: prayer + ignoring

② Serious threats - physical danger  
4:7-14 - Response: prayer + ignoring  
Trusts God's protection. But buckles on sword in case

③ Internal dissension & division  
5:1-13 Resp: Take action + resolve conflict  
discipline & keep on top

④ Offer of Compromise from enemy  
6:1-9 Resp: Refuse utterly - reject proposals

⑤ Treachery from close friends  
6:10-14 Resp: discerns in time, takes  
measures in time. Discipline
