Scene -- Mother and 3 children in the corner of a living room.

Mother: "What a lovely Christmas this year! All of you gave me too many presents, you simply must cut back on my gifts next year! Look at this living room, children, it looks like a department store -- really it does.

And speaking of stores, did you children see the expression on the butcher's face yesterday when I told him I needed oysters for breakfast? It was too funny! "Oysters for breakfast?" he exclaimed -- "Yes," I answered, "we always have oyster stew for breakfast on Christmas Day." Then I had to go on and explain about being raised in China and how we always had oysters for breakfast out there until it became a family custom which your father and I have carried on."

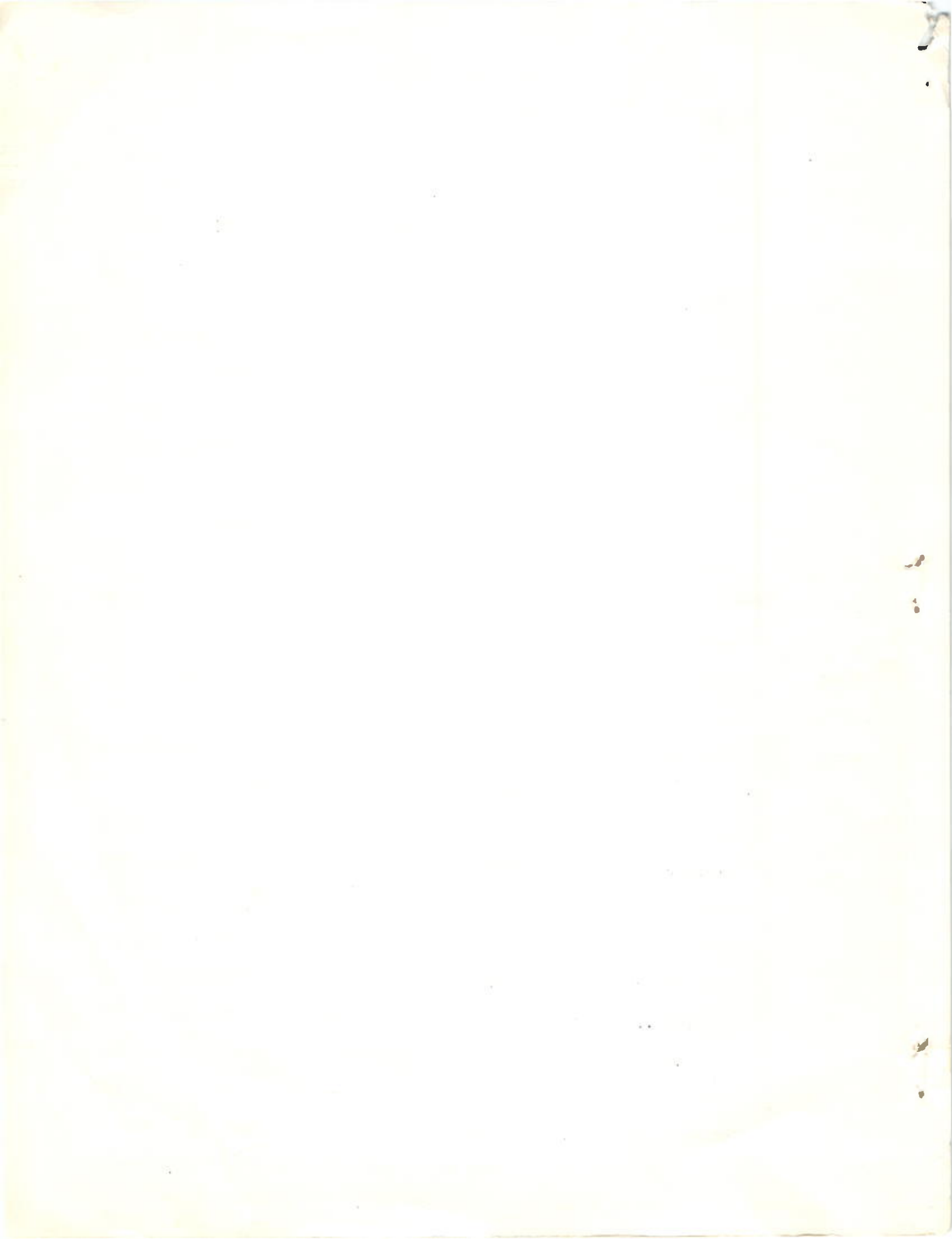
1st Child: "I must say it is a funny custom. None of my friends have oyster stew for breakfast on Christmas Day."

2nd Child: "Yes, and they are luckier than us. I hate old oyster stew!"

3rd Child: "Me, too! And what is a 'custom' anyway, Mother?"

Mother: "Some other time I'll explain what a custom is. Now, children, let's all calm down. Get yourselves comfortable. It's time for the Christmas story.

1st Child: "What do you mean, Mother? It's about Jesus being born and the angels and the shepherds -- and that's the Christmas story, isn't it?"

Mother: "Did you notice that the angel called this Baby a Saviour? If He was a Saviour, what was He to save us from?"

2nd Child: "I never noticed before that the angel said the Baby Jesus was a Saviour."

3rd Child: "What is a Saviour anyway, Mother?"

Mother: "Let me see, how can I explain it to you. Let's say you fell through the ice when you went skating last Friday, and a man rushed up pulling you out of the water to safety. That man would be your Saviour. Do you see?"

Children nod.

Mother continues: "Yes, there is a lot more to the Christmas story than the birth of Jesus; and it is the most exciting true story that happened."

All Children: "Tell us, Mother, tell us all of it!"

EXCEPT FOR ONE FAMILY, ONE RIGHTEOUS FAMILY - NOAH AND HIS THREE SONS AND THEIR FAMILIES. GOD COMMANDED NOAH TO BUILD AN ARK, FOR THE SAFEKEEPING OF HIS FAMILY, AND THROUGH HIM THE PROMISED SAVIOUR. THE FLOOD OF WATERS THEN SWEEPED THE EARTH DESTROYING ALL FLESH, WHILE THE EIGHT SOULS, NOAH AND HIS FAMILY ALONE, WITHIN THE ARK, WERE SAVED. THE FLOOD LASTED ONE YEAR AND TEN DAYS. BEFORE ISRAEL'S DELIVERANCE WAS COMPLETE, HOWEVER, GOD HAD TO SEND TEN FLAGUES TO THE EGYPTIANS. AT THE LAST PLAGUE THE "PASSOVER" WAS INSTITUTED.

AFTER SEVERAL HUNDRED YEARS AND AGAINST THE WILL OF GOD, THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL DEMANDED A KING. SAUL WAS CHOSEN TO BE THE FIRST KING OF ISRAEL. HE WAS A KING OF SELF WILL AND AFTER 40 YEARS REIGN DIED A MISERABLE DEATH.

THE REIGN OF DAVID WAS THE BRIGHTEST PART OF ISRAEL'S HISTORY. HE ALSO REIGNED 40 YEARS.

SOLOMON, SON OF DAVID WAS ISRAEL'S LAST KING WHERE ALL THE TRIBES WERE UNITED. DURING THIS TIME THE TEMPLE AT JERUSALEM WAS BUILT.

IN SPITE OF ALL SOLOMON'S WISDOM, HE DID VERY FOOLISH AND BAD THINGS. BECAUSE KING SOLOMON DID NOT KEEP THE LORD'S COMMANDMENTS, GOD WOULD TAKE THE KINGDOM AWAY FROM HIM. THE KINGDOM OF JUDAH LASTED 135 YEARS AFTER THE FALL OF THE KINGDOM OF ISRAEL. JUDAH WAS REIGNED OVER BY 19 KINGS AND ONE QUEEN, ALL WERE DESCENDANTS OF DAVID, THUS THE RIGHTEOUS SEED WHICH WAS TO BRING FORTH THE SAVIOUR OF THE WORLD WAS PRESERVED.

THE END CAME WITH THE DESTRUCTION OF JERUSALEM BY KING NEBUCHADNEZZAR, AND THE FINAL CAPTIVITY OF ITS KING AND PEOPLE WITH THEM BEING TAKEN TO BABYLON. THE BEAUTIFUL TEMPLE WAS BURNT TO THE GROUND. THIS IS THE PERIOD OF DANIEL.

AFTER 70 YEARS OF CAPTIVITY IN BABYLON A SMALL NUMBER OF JEWS RETURNED TO JERUSALEM AND REBUILT THE TEMPLE.

(Scene 8 - Mother and Children)

Mother: "So children, that is the story of the part of our Bible which is called the Old Testament."

1st Child: "What happened next mother? Is it time for the Lord Jesus to be born?"

Mother: "Almost \_\_\_\_\_." "You see there were about 400 years between the Old Testament and the New Testament. God's word tells us nothing about these years."

2nd Child: "Nothing at all!"

Mother: "Not one word, so we have to go to other writings to find out what happened. We know that the history of Israel during these years was one of terrible bloodshed. But in their darkest hours a faithful few guarded with their very lives the old testament canon - that was what they called their Bible."

1st Child: "They must have loved God very much."

Mother: "Yes they did, with their whole heart and God honored them with the greatest gift of all."

Mother: "God was ready for Christmas, and the gift He was giving the world was so priceless and so rare that He could not place it in unworthy hands. You see, children, God had planned a way to bring His <sup>people</sup> children back to Him, the children He had lost - and that way was Christmas."

1st Child: "God must have loved them very much to still want them back after the mean way they acted."

Mother: "Yes, these people had disappointed Him so often. They had brought Him little but sorrow ever since He had created them. He had given them the power to choose and they had chosen to disobey Him. He had created them to be His friends, and they spent most of their time fighting each other. He had talked with them and they had turned away. But God's love does not wear out. Yes \_\_\_\_\_, He loved them very much. He knew that by themselves they could never find their way back to Him. It didn't matter whether He started with Adam or Noah, with bad men or good men; sooner or later everyone wanders outside His plan and is hopelessly separated from Him. This is the Christmas gift God was planning. He was going to send His Son to earth as a human baby."

3rd Shepherd: "Bethlehem is certainly crowded tonight with all the people who have come to be taxed. They said the inn was full this afternoon."

1st Shepherd: "I still think something is queer tonight. Look over there; isn't that a light in the east?"

2nd Shepherd: "You're right! There is a glow -- a strange one, too!"

3rd Shepherd:"See, it's growing brighter -- much brighter."

1st Shepherd:"What makes it? Is the world on fire?"

Narrator: "And lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them and the glory of the Lord shone round about them; and they were sore afraid."

Angel (boy's voice from balcony):

Narrator:

I BRING MYRRH FOR THE KING'S HUMANITY.

(Kneel down and worship at the rail)

Mother:

"What a moment that would have been! Just think -- you could have reached out your own hand and touched the Son of God, had you been there with the shepherds and wisemen!

There the baby Jesus lay sleeping -- sleeping as though the world had not waited thousands of years for this moment. As soundly as though from this moment on all the sin and sorrow of the world were not His problem."

1st Child:

"And then He grew up in Nazareth. I would like to have known Jesus then."

Mother:

"Yes, we know very little about him as a boy, but we do know he was a good obedient son to his earthly parents. The Bible says "Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man."
