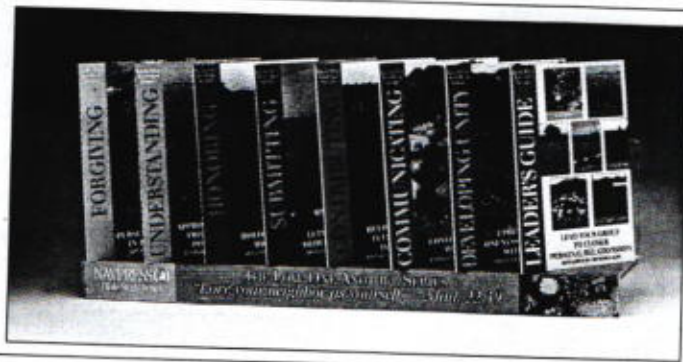

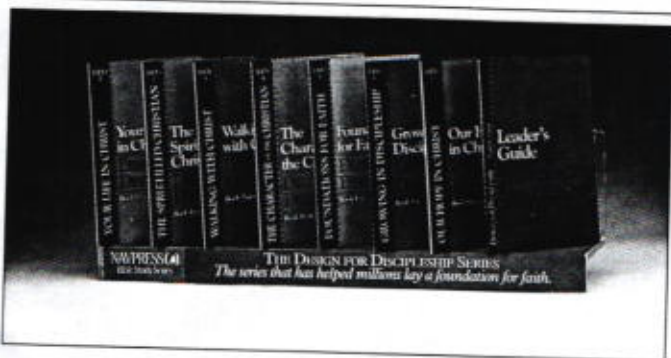

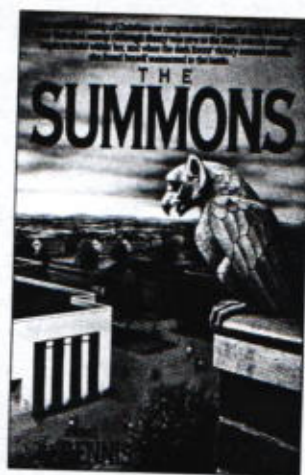
NEW FICTION
