Moses

In Ps. 103:7 — The Most High "Made known His WAYS unto Moses, His acts unto the children of Israel"

He looked Beyond the circumstances (Pharaoh, Red Sea)

→ Moses endured steadfastly, as one who gazed — on Him who is invisible

→ To see only the acts of God is to walk by sight, but to learn His ways to walk by FAITH

I don't know any time in history when it is more necessary for men and women like Moses — than the present time.

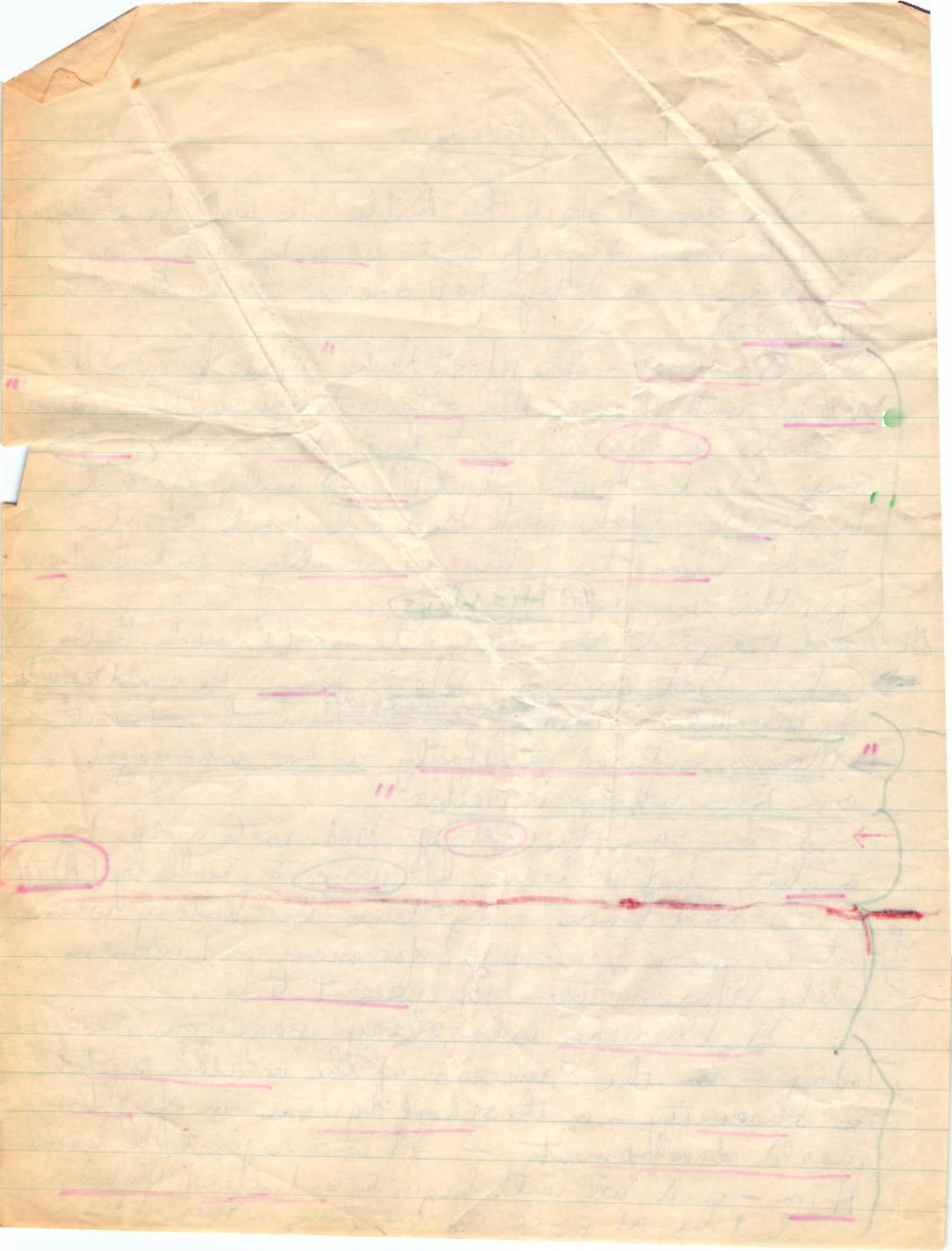
