

## PROPHECY

13. Great Tribulation will begin (7 years) with:

a) Defense pact between Jewish leader and Roman dictator (Isa 2)

b) Multitudes will believe (Rev. 17)

c) Last 3 and a half years of great tribulation the Jewish false prophet will proclaim the Roman dictator god and demand worship of him, (abomination of desolation)

d) Russia will invade, Arabia will invade, more than half of the World's population will be destroyed; Christians massacred;

e) World-wide rationing system will be established, can buy nothing without seal on forehead which proves worship of anti-Christ as god.

f) The Roman empire versus the Asiatic powers and five-sixths of their men killed (Battle of Armageddon) Dan. 11:40-44; Ez 38 and 39

g) There will be a heavenly sign that Christ will return to save His people Isa. 24,34,63; Zech. 12-14; Rev. 16-19; Matt. 24. All the unbelievers will unite to fight Christ.

h) Judgment of all living peoples, both Jews and Gentile, and those remaining will repopulate the earth. Satan bound for 1000 years.
