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## Revelation 1-2

Revelation means the "unveiling" - the "apocalypse" of the Day of the Lord -

It is actually the revelation of J.C. given to John the Apostle when he was on the Isle of Patmos

- a) It deals with the sins of this present age
- b) The terrors of the time between
- c) And the blessings of the time to come

The book of revelation is the unveiling of Jesus Christ in his future glory when he comes again as King of Kings & Lord of Lords

Don't study the book to get all excited about the weird symbols + pictures + the anti-Christ

It is a book of unveiling Christ -

**He** is the One to focus on  
As you study the book of Revelation you will receive blessing (v. 3)

(v. 5) J.C. released us from our sins - Such good news!  
Just-born = prominence

(v. 6) made us a kingdom of priests - this is what he made us - the Body of Christ

(v. 7) Acts 1:8 - J.C. ascended into heaven - a cloud received him out of their sight - they just stood there looking - "This same Jesus shall come again in the same way & the same place"
