



Acts - 2: 22-36 - Impromptu sermon
by Peter - powerful, logical, brilliant
This is an awesome POWER available to
the believer (e.g. Man in Westerville - 2 wks.)

v. 27 God will not abandon David to the grave
Because Jesus (the Holy One) would not stay
in the grave guarantees that David will
resurrect - David was not talking
about himself - he died

v. 30 - David was a prophet - knew that one of his
descendants was going to reign on his own throne
forever.

v. 34 David could not have been talking about
himself

Peter was using the fulfillment of prophecy -
in a powerful way - to present Christ

Acts. 13:16 -

the highway (e.g. Main in Westville - 2 miles)

10-31 David will not be in the group
because James (the help) would not stay
in the group. I mentioned that David will
be out to avoid what was talking
about himself in the group

11-30 David was a prophet in town that will
be a prophet who is going to sign in his own house

1-31 David would not have been talking about
himself

Peter was using the fulfillment of prophecy
to fulfill the word of the prophet Isaiah
