(Mt. 12: 38) Jesus prophesied He would literally lie in the grave & literally rise in his body like Jonah returned from the monster

(Mk. 8: 31³²) "He was stating the matter plainly"

(9: 31-32) - "Rise again"

Historical Circumstantial Evidences

What is this evidence?

Jesus said: That this ^{is the} Sign which would PROVE that he was who he claimed to be - his whole case rested on this claim

EMPTY TOMB

Pharisees + Scribes

(Mt. 21: 62-66) - these men knew what the fulfillment of Jesus' claim would do for the movement.

Guard 16 Roman legionnaires could stand off a large number of men, most fantastic soldiers in all of history

(b) The grave secure → seal of Caesar in Wax String
All the power of the Roman empire backed that seal → be prepared to die if you broke it

(c) In addition - Stone rolls in a crevasse - weighs 2 ton → 5' x 3' opening (Mk. 16: 4)

(Mt. 28: 11-15) Watch was terrified - they would be crucified

III UNDISTURBED GRAVE CLOTHS

(Jo. 19: 38 - 42)

100 lbs. spread on the cloths + bound
the limbs + body
Myrrh -> shellac, Aloes -> resin
Set hard like a mummy in 24 hrs.

(Jo. 20: 1 - 9)

v. 5 -> "saw" = a hurried glance (John)

v. 6 -> "beheld" = studied - (Peter)

v. 8 -> "saw" = saw + believed that Jesus
had been raised from the dead

What did John see? Exact shape of Jesus but
He was not there; Jesus' body had assumed
another dimension as He rose from the dead

VII EXISTENCE OF CHRISTIANITY TODAY
Theories to explain away the resurrection:

① Swoon theory (Schofield, the Passover Plot)

Premise that Jesus really wasn't dead

- got up & showed himself to disciples

(a) spear in heart - dead for some time

(b) condition of grave clothes

(c) legionnaires, knowing that they would be crucified, would fight to keep him from escaping

(d) how could he be the 'Lord of life' in weakened condition

(e) Joseph of A. & Nicodemus would have noticed

② Disciples stole the Body -

(a) How did they get them the Roman guard
→ many would have been killed - disciples as well as Romans

(b) Disciples taught that Jesus died & rose for sins - at the peril of their own lives

V FLEXIBILITY OF CHRISTIANITY TODAY

(1) Principles of the Protestant Reformation

Because that Jesus Christ alone is our Lord and our Righteousness, we will not have any other Lord or Righteousness, neither will we have any other mediator between us and God.

(2) Principles of the Roman Catholic Church

The Roman Catholic Church teaches that there are seven sacraments, that the Pope is the successor of St. Peter and the head of the Church, and that the Church has the authority to bind and loose on earth, which shall be bound and loosed in heaven.

(3) Principles of the Anglican Church

The Anglican Church is a middle way between the Roman Catholic Church and the Protestant Reformation. It teaches that the Bible is the Word of God, that the sacraments are important, and that the Church has authority to bind and loose on earth.

(4) Principles of the Methodist Church

The Methodist Church is a Protestant denomination that emphasizes personal holiness and social justice. It teaches that the Bible is the Word of God, that the sacraments are important, and that the Church has authority to bind and loose on earth.
