a moment of Rage

Moses never did get complete control of his temper - he never learned how to trust God in this area

① (Ex. 21:10-15) Moses killed the Egyptian who hid him in the sand

② (Ex. 11:4-8) "Moses went out from Pharaoh in hot anger" - strongest Hebrew language

③ (Ex. 32:19) - "Moses' anger burned"
This is the time when he saw the Israelites worshipping the golden calf & having an orgy. He threw down the 2 tablets on which God had written the 10 Commandments.

→ Why break these precious tablets?
That was uncontrolled anger - & God made Moses write the next set of 10 commandments - an implied rebuke of God is so patient with us in our areas of indwelling habitual sin -

④ But let's turn to Num. 20:1-13.
We find here that the Israelites had been wandering in the wilderness for 38½ yrs. - and they'd been complaining every step of the way. Remember they had refused to go into Canaan because of unbelief & God had decreed that the older generation should not enter the land - that only Joshua & Caleb could enter.
