When He trained & taught His disciples He told many parables about the Kingdom of God - about its characteristics, that it is internal, "it is within you" that you should become like a child to enter it

What I want to ask at the outset

of this segment is:

- Q How does one get into this Kingdom of God?

We are not automatically sons & daughters of God → we are created by God, not begotten - what God begets is God -

The same essence → only Jesus Christ same essence
What God creates is not God → but

we are created "in His image" which means in His faculties we are thinking, feeling, volitional beings

We are created with free will and have the privilege of containing God's life. God clearly made plain to Adam the law of his being → (i.e.) Adam was a created being & God was his authority.

3 New Δ's Charact

Adam will-fully de-throned God & deified himself as god when he followed Satan's suggestion that he could be 'as god' - all of us ^{are} self-willed people.

At that point Adam cut himself off from God and disqualified himself (and all of us) to enter God's Kingdom - now we need a life other than the life we have by nature.

- BIOS - or biological physical life - we need a new nature - ZOE - eternal divine life to be members of God's Eternal Divine Kingdom.

(i.e.) we need the life of God to be in God's Kingdom. The voice was life or death.

Separation from God to contain God's life or death.

But as a result of the FALL - (i.e.) Adam's choice against God) we are under the sentena of death, alienated from God, by our sins and unable to restore ourselves. God says

Isa 59:2 "your sins have made a separation between you + your God"

Rom 6:23 "The wages of sin is death"

3 Show Panorama of Δ 's Redemptive Plan

1 But even after the fall God's Kingdom continues without being derailed or destroyed by Satan or man's rebellion

2 also God continues to be involved with His created men & women

3 Now God begins His Redemptive Plan right in the Garden of Eden

which is "the promise of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised long centuries ago" (Titus 1:2)

~~In Gen. 3:15~~

This separation from God is impossible for man to bridge \rightarrow or to surmount the barrier. We are sinners |||| God is +R Holy.

Separation requires Reconciliation

All through the O.T. God reveals details of His Plan to Redeem us - buy us back - from death since Adam gave the title deed of life to Satan we have all been under the sentence of death - "slavery of death" (Heb. 2:14-15)

So God initiated His Redemptive Plan and all thru the O.T. He revealed more + more details of His Plan

Shadows \rightarrow 1. (Gen. 3:15) - the Promise that one day there would come One who would crush Satan

\rightarrow 2. That the way God would handle the problems of our sin + death was by an innocent life substituting for our guilty life
