6 things God says about my mind:

1. Made to Think
(Gen. 1:26) - God talking to Himself
(love-communic. - creation sprang out of nature of the Creator)
God thinks - we also think
(Gen. 2:7 Work demands rationality)
named animals - nothing the same as and yet different than himself (woman) in a corresponding way

2. Gen 3:6 - Darkens the Mind
Change in mankind - rationality is darkened - not able to think straight about everything

5. Radical activism - don't think - just get something done

6. Hyper-emotionalism - experience divorced from the truth.
